

The Rose Caucus exists to bring to fruition; the emancipation of all poor and working people; a truly democratic economy with power in the hands of workers; the liberation of all oppressed and marginalized peoples; the primacy of Indigenous sovereignty; the rights of all migrants to live, work, and learn in Canada; a decent and dignified life for all seniors; and the guarantee that everyone who lives here is housed, clothed and fed.

It is crucial to win and transform political power. While we root ourselves in community work and organizing for mass struggle, all essential to challenge the hegemony of capital and colonial rule and to prove other ways of living, their action alone cannot suffice. The Rose Caucus exists to bring together these struggles into a mass, democratic movement that can seize the levers of our Party and, through it, the Canadian state: to turn our party into the instrument by which workers, migrants, farmers and Indigenous peoples take power and begin to establish a democratic, cooperative, socialist Canada.

Our vision is of a party that stands in living solidarity with the global working class, that breaks with Canada's complicity in US-led imperialism and resource plunder, and that fights for liberation, justice, and self-determination for all peoples. Our Caucus works to realize a Party that confronts corporate power without compromise, rebuilds our democracy from below, and helps lay the foundations for a democratic socialist Canada; a Canada where the people themselves decide, and where the power of free and equal people prevails over the forces of capital.
